M. B. King, his heirs & assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Grove Township,
State and County aforesaid, near the Village of Piedmont, and being on the East side
of the road leading from Piedmont to Greenville and facing on said road and extending
back to the track of the Southern Railway Company, containing one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) acre, more
or less, and adjoining lot of L. S. Mauney on the North, Southern Railway Company on
the East and lot formerly owned by Graten Little on the South and having the follow-
ing dimensions:

Beginning at a stone 3x on Southern Railroad, center of railroad track,
thence N. $67\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.50 to the center of the aforesaid public road; thence, along
