All our right, title, interest and estate of in or to all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, about 7 miles North of Greenville C.H., and containing twenty-one (21) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of R. Y. Rosemond, Joe Davison and Estate of Rev. Bill (now or formerly), and is the same land conveyed by Malony Hawkins to St. S.
