All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on Birnie Street, corner of a ten-foot alley and running thence with Birnie Street, S. 60 1/2 E. 84 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 4; thence along line of said lot, N. 28 1/2 E. 170 feet to a stake on line of lot No. 2; thence N. 60 1/2 W. 64 feet to a stake on a above mentioned alley; thence S. 28 1/2 W. 170 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to LuJania Compton by Lizzie Dawkins by deed dated January 23, 1906, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. RRR at page 474.

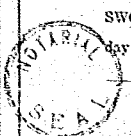
