Beginning at an iron pin at the southeast corner of East Washington and Spring Streets and running thence with the south side of East Washington Street, S. 70 E. 50.5 feet to a pin; thence S. 20 W. 100.6 feet to a pin on a ten foot alley; thence with said alley N. 70 W. 50.5 feet to a pin on Spring Street, thence with the east side of Spring Street N. 20 E. 100.6 feet to the beginning corner.
