to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Doris H. Williamson

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the East side of Augusta Road, being known and designated as Lots numbers 32, 33 and 34, with so much of the alley as lies between lot numbers 32 and 33 and 34, being of the same lots and alley designated on a plat of the property of Charles and Rector, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County, in Plat Book "C" at page 153, said lots being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the southeastern corner of the intersection of Riverside Drive and Augusta Road at the corner of Lot number 33, and running thence along Augusta Road to the line of lots numbers 33 and 34, to the corner of Lot number 35; thence along the line of lots number 34 and Number 35, to the alley hereinabove mentioned; thence in a straight line across said alley to the line dividing lots numbers 32 and 33; thence along said line to the front corner of lots numbers 31, 32, 37 and 38; thence along said line between lots Numbers 31 and 32, to the corner of said lots on Riverside Drive; thence along Riverside Drive, along the line of Lot Number 32, to said alley; thence across said alley in a straight line to the line of Lot number 33; thence along the line of Lot Number 33 to the beginning corner, where Riverside Drive and Augusta Road intersect; it being the intent by this deed to convey to the grantee all of lots numbers 32, 33, 34 and the alley lying between said lots, and that said alley shall henceforth be closed and become a part of these lots and shall no longer be open to the public, as provided in the Deed of J.P. Williamson to the grantor, dated October 16, 1934.
