all that piece, parcel or lot of land
situate lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville
County, South Carolina.

Beginning on a stake on St. G. Barton's line on Pat
Creek, thence up said creek N. 27° W. 17.00 chains to a
bend in said creek; thence N. 82° W. 6.80 chains to a
bend, thence S. 67° E. 3.50 chains to a bend, thence S.
67° E. 2.30 chains to a Hickory corner on the south
bank of Pat Creek; thence S. 47° E. 8.08 chains to a
stone; thence N. 71° E. 13.00 chains to a stone, thence
S. 26° E. 27.50 chains to a red oak; thence N. 75° W.
10.80 chains to the head of the branch; thence along
the branch as the line with St. G. Barton's line to a
stake on Pat Creek about 23.00 chains to the
beginning corner, and containing forty five acres
