All that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in State and County aforesaid; Glassy Mountain Township, about three miles West of the Town of Landrum and being a portion of lot No. 1 as shown on survey and plat of Mr. T. W. Belue's lands, made by E. P. Morrow, Surveyor, on March 22, 1935, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances:

Beginning at a stone, Solomon Morgan's corner in Boone's line and running N. 87 W. 17.95 chains to a stone; thence S. 60 E. 12.35 chains to a chestnut stump; thence S. 75 E. 21.65 chains to a stone, Morgan's corner; thence S. 34 E. 30.12 chains to the beginning corner, containing twenty-two and 38/100 (32.39) acres, more or less.

This being a part of the land conveyed to me by Master of Greenville County, May 25, 1923, less twenty acres sold to Solomon Morgan Jan. 18, 1935. Said Deed Book 110, page 70.
