Beginning at iron pin on east side of Rutherford Road Chaudier's corner thence S. 38° 45' 402' to pin in Rutherford Road, thence S. 29° 45' W. 9 feet to middle of road with iron pin on East bank of road, thence S. 77° 45' E. 657' to iron pin, Batson's corner, thence N. 3° 30' E. 396' to pin, Batson's corner, thence N. 78° 30' W. 455' to the beginning corner, and containing five acres more or less, as per survey partially made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, June 6th, 1936, and being a portion of a tract conveyed by Thomas W. Butler to W. P. Cason by deed bearing date Feb 20th, 1934 and recorded in R.M.C.
