All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying, situate and being on Southwest side of Augusta Road, in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, and being known and designated as lots Nos. 3 and 4 and a portion of lots Nos. 18 and 19, according to plat made by R. E. Dalton, C. E., August 1922, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on West side of Augusta Road, at joint corner of lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence along joint line of said lots Nos. 2 and 3, and also joint line of lots 19 and 20 S. 62-27 W. 404.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 26-31 W. 200 feet to a stake in joint line of lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence along joint line of said lots Nos. 17 and 18, and also joint line of lots Nos. 4 and 5 N. 62-27 E. 401.5 feet to an iron pin on West side of said Augusta Road; thence along West side of said Augusta Road S. 27-29 E. 200 feet to the beginning point.

Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by R. A. Ellison, as shown by deed dated July 31, 1926, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. in Volume 107, Page 375.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Augusta Road, being a part of lots Nos. 17, 18, 19, and 20 as shown on plat of the G. L. Walker property, said plat recorded in Plat Book "H", page 18, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on a 40 foot street 395.4 feet from the Augusta Road, and running thence S. 26-31 E. 398.6 feet to a point 390 feet from the Augusta Road; thence S. 62-27 W. 100 feet; thence N. 26-31 W. 398.6 feet to point on a 40-foot street, 495.4 feet from the Augusta Road; thence with said 40-foot street N. 62-27 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner

Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Lucile S. Boyd and Hattie S. Moran as shown by deed dated February 1930, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Volume 137, Page 278.

Also, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Augusta Road, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat made by R. E. Dalton, September 1922, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", at page 18 and being all of lot No. 5 as shown on said plat and 50 feet off the rear of lot No. 17. Beginning at an iron pin on Augusta Street, corner of Lot No. 4, and running thence with line of Lot No. 4 S. 62-27 W. 401.5 feet; thence N. 26-31 W. 100 feet to new street; thence with said street as a line N. 62-27 E. 395.4 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road S. 30-02 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
