All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, in subdivision known as Kanhtenah and designated as Lot No. 7 of Block "E" on the revised plat of said property recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F" at page 131, and having the following metes and bounds. to-wit:-

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Oregon Street, 60 feet west of the corner of Oregon and Fuller Streets, being the joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, and running thence along the south side of said Oregon Street, S. 63-35 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 6; thence running along the line of Lot No. 6, S. 26-30 E. 165 feet to a stake, rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence N. 63-35 E. 60 feet to rear corner of Lot No. 8; thence along the line of Lot No. 8, N. 26-30 W. 165 feet to the beginning corner.
