on the White Horse Road, about four miles from Greenville Courthouse, known as tract No. 5 of the lands of R. A. Means deceased (see Plat Book H, page 144), containing 10 acres and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat by W. A. Hester, May 9, 1929.

Beginning at a stake on south side of White Horse Road, corner of lands of Alice M. Moore, thence with her line S. 35 1/2 W. 10.71 chains to iron pin; thence S. 48 3/4 E. 6.90 chains to stone o.m.; thence S. 49 3/4 E. 1.28 chains to stone n.m.; thence with line of tract No. 1 N. 36 3/4 E. 14.55 chains to stake in White Horse Road; thence with White Horse Road N. 70 W. 8.05 to the beginning.
