All that certain piece parcel or lot of land,
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina
County of Greenville Greenville Township just outside the
corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and
designated as Lot no One Hundred Sixty, according to
Plat no Four of the Overbrook Land Company's property,
which plat was made in March, 1924, by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor,
which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book 1, at page 235, said property being
described by metes and bounds, as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northwest corner
of Lot no 60 as shown on said plat, which point of
beginning is the intersection of the south line of Overbrook
Road with the east line of Circle Street and running
thence along the east side of Circle Street south 31-48'
East 100 feet to an iron pin, thence south 42 feet to an
iron pin, thence north 71-13 East 59-7 feet to an iron
pin; thence N. 17-47 West 128-3 feet to an iron pin;
thence south 79-21 West 77 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the identical lot of land conveyed to
me by the Overbrook Land Company by Deed recorded
in Volume 73, at page 183, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
