All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina in Saluda Township, on Head Waters of Mush Creek, having the following notes and bounds to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the Mush Creek Road on the original Bailey line, thence along said road in a westerly direction 14.83 chains to forks of road; thence along said road in a southerly direction 12.49 chains to a stake on east side of road; thence N. 44.4 E. 2.60 chains to a stone; thence S 59 E 4.12 chains to a small wild cherry (dead) at a spring; thence down a spring branch as a line 22.45 chains to a stone on left bank of branch (Bailey corner); thence N. 29 W. with the original Bailey line 14.30 chains to the beginning corner in Mush Creek Road, containing 28 ³/₄ acres more or less, and bounded by lands of G. M. McKinney, M. R. Forest and others.

This is the same tract of land conveyed to me by J. F. Hawkins by deed dated December 11, 1912, recorded in R. M. C. O. for Greenville County in Deed Book 20, at page 433.
