(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Walford Humphrey and Emma Humphrey, their heirs and assigns:

All our right, title and interest in to all that certain lot of land situate in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, called North Calhoun Street and being designated as a portion of Lot No 2 in the division of the Estate of M. A. Callahan, deceased.

Beginning at a stake on Calhoun Street at the corner of lot formerly owned by E. S. Roundtree and thence running with the line of Calhoun Street S 18 1/2 N. 46 feet to a stake; thence S 71 1/2 E. 19.3 feet to a stake; thence N 20.4 N. 57 1/2, more or less, to a stake at the corner of E. S. Roundtree's lot; thence along the line of that lot N 71 1/2 N. 157 feet, more or less, to a stake on Calhoun Street at the beginning corner and being part of the property conveyed to R. Y. Hellman by E. Luman, Master on January 8, 1925, by deed recorded in Volume 94, at page 274.
