Clarence Boatlee

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that parcel or lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid being about three miles north of the City of Greenville, and being lot no 400 of a tract of land known as the Columbia Company tract and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Berkley Ave; thence S. 24-13 E. 139.8 feet to an iron pin in the corner of lot no 240; thence running the rear line of lots nos 239 and 240 S. 32-5 S. 130 feet to an iron pin, point corner of lots 238 and 239; thence N. 24-13 W. 210.3 feet to an iron pin, on Berkley Ave.; with Berkley Ave. N. 65-47 E. 109.2 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, and also shown by a call made by Dalton & Neves, June 1930.

This lot being subject to the following restrictions and conditions: This lot or subdivision thereof to be used for residence purposes only, and for white people, said residence to cost not less than \$3500.00.

Said lot being crossed by a small stream or branch, is subject to all natural drainage flowing across said lot, and also subject to sewerage easement or right of way for the purpose of making sewerage connections for lot no 240.
