known as Lot #9 in plat of survey of lands of which Martha J. Howell died seized and possessed  
made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, on the 10th day of March, 1914, having the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on Spartanburg Road, thence N. 42° E. 95 ft. to a stone; thence N.  
9 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 190 feet to a stake corner of lot #10, thence S. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 222 feet to a stake; thence  
S. 48 E. 203.4 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lot #9 and being one of the lots  
deeded to R. J. Rowley and T. F. Hunt by J. W. Gray, Master, by deed recorded April 25, 1914,  
in Vol. 14, page 202.

The above described lot is the same that is known and designated as Nos. 1405 and 1407  
North Street Extension. That subdivision being situate on the Spartanburg Road.

This deed is an absolute conveyance of title in effect as well as in form and is not  
intended as a mortgage, trust conveyance, or security of any kind. The consideration therefor  
is full release of all debts, obligations, costs, and charges heretofore subsisting on  
account of and by the terms of that certain mortgage from Ida Rosamond to The Penn Mutual  
Life Insurance Company, dated July 1st, 1927, and recorded in Book 126, at page 25, of the  
official records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, herefore existing on the  
property herein conveyed, and the note secured thereby, this conveyance completely satisfying  
said obligation and terminating said mortgage and note and all effect thereof in every  
respect.
