NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars to me paid by the said *Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh*, a corporation,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh*, a corporation All that certain tract of land, containing 127 acres, more or less, situated in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having such metes and bounds as will more fully appear by reference to a plat thereof of H. A.
