Heyward,

on or about the 13th day of August, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four exhibited their complaint in the Court of County Court, for the County aforesaid, against Lucinda Heyward, John Thompson, Rebecca Thompson, Iola Thompson, and Roy Thompson,

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of November 1934 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

to be sold by public outcry on the 7th day of January, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto General Heyward,

for the sum of Two Hundred Thirty Five (\$235.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men By These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Thirty Five (\$235.00) Dollars to me paid by the said General Heyward,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto General Heyward,

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying about three and one half miles from Greenville Court House, near the section known as "Freetown" and being a part of a tract conveyed to Robert Wilson by Bessie Edens, deed dated December 13, 1905, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book RRR, page 228, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of Lot No. 1, (Mary Heyward's lot), and running thence along the road S. 13-30 E. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-30 W. 417.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 13-30 W. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-30 E. 417.8 feet to iron pin; beginning corner, being known as Lot No. 2 on plat made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, recorded in Plat Book C, Page 55, said R. M. C. Office."
