TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS

WHEREAS, American Building and Loan Association, a Corporation

on the 29th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand and thirty four exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid against E. Mack Gillespie, et al.

and the judgment rendered in the case hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 20th day of November 1934. In such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

that the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to the highest bidder therefor, the terms of sale by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the

same, on the 4th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand and thirty five did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and convey the same unto J. T. Gillespie,

the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

AND WHEREFORE I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, paid to me by J. T. Gillespie,

do hereby witness that I, E. INMAN, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. T. Gillespie,

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 8 of Highland Ave. and having a frontage of 50 feet on said Ave. and running back in parallel lines a distance of 125 feet to a 15 foot alley and adjoining Lot No. 9 on the East and Lot No. 7 on the West in Block "V", as shown by plat of the subdivision of "Riverside" recorded in Plat Book "A", page 323, said subdivision being situated near Bonaghan Mills, being the same lot of land conveyed to Mary J. Cartledge by J. W. McAllister by his deed dated October 6, 1924, recorded in Vol. 83, page 368, P. M. C. Office for Greenville County."
