TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS Metropolitan Life Insurance Company.

on or about the 22nd day of January in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five exhibited its complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against John Brissey, et al

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 23rd,
day of February 1935 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. being at that price the highest bidder thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Thirty five Hundred (\$3500.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said Metropolitan Life Insurance Company

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Metropolitan Life Insurance Company

"All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the south side of Arlington Avenue, and having, according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December 1925, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a post on the South side of Arlington Avenue, which post is 201 feet West of Calhoun Street, and running thence S. 18-00 W. 150 feet to a stake; thence N. 72-00 W. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 18-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Arlington Avenue; thence with the Southern side of said Avenue, S. 72-00 E. 50 feet to a post, the point of beginning."
