Know all wen by these presents: That the undersigned, of said County and State bereinsfter called Grantor, for and in considerations of the terms, ocaditions and privileges hereinafter expressed, and the sum L. One (\$1.00) Dellar to the Granter in hand paid by PARKER Water and Sewer Sub-District, of Greenville, South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Grantes, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract or lot of land situate in Groenville Tomship, in said County and State, and described as follows: Those contain lots I and being located on Hampton are Extention about 2 miles month west from the City of December a dyorning land of Charlie and W. W. Campbell. and to construct, maintain in and upon and use in and through said prawises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances such as machinery, air vents, manholdo, blow-off connections and any and every other necessary and proper attachment, pipe lines, for water and severage purposes through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter in and upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting and making necessary repairs and alterations of said line, together with the right to out away

danger the proper operations of same. It Is Understood and agreed: That the easement herein granted shall extend throughout the property of the Grantor about 240 feet, and small be of such width as the Grantee shall deem necessary for the purposes herein specified, and that the domage for which said Grantee may be held liable shall be confined to that arising from the use of this strip only, and nothing beyond.

It is further agreed and understood: That this easement is to be used only during the construction or repair of said pigs lines and with the exception of the right of the Grantes, its successors and assigns, agents, servents, and employees to inspect said rips lines and to enter at any point and make repairs, the Grantor has the right to cultivate and use the land; provided, however, that this shall not apply to such part wherein the top of the pipe is less than dighteen (18) inches underground.

It Is further agreed: "hat, as a part of the consideration hereof, the Grantor herein and the heirs and assigns of the same, may make taps or connections with said pipe lines bearing the expense thereof, provided, however, that such connections or taps be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineers representing the Grantes, its successors and essigns.

It is further understood and agreed: That in case of future demage to crops or property due from accident in said pipe lines, the Grantes shall pay reasonable damage thorefor .

The payment and privileges above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages for said easement.
