Know all men by these presents that W. J. & F. J. Jones as Trustees for the heirs at law of the estate of William T. Jones, late of Simpsonville, S. C.

do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the original as the same appears in the records of the County of Greenville, South Carolina.

ARTICLE II

Section 1.

That certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Simpson Township, County and State aforesaid and in the Town of Simpsonville, with metes and bounds, to-wit:

beginning at a point on the S/S of the Georgia Road, at bridge across Mill-
bank, Branlett's corner, and running thence with Branlett's line S. 16 W. 431' to the
S/S of a new street - cut through Branlett's farm and extending toward the two-story
brick residence of R. C. Jones' thence along the S/S of said new street N. 61 W. 51.3'
to a point, thence along another new street - cut out of the estate of the said William
T. Jones and connecting the above described new street with the Georgia Road - S. 8-45
W. 413' to the beginning corner, bounded on the north and east by the two streets newly
cut and on the west by lands of B. L. Branlett, being a part of the lands conveyed to
us by J. S. Jones, et al by deed dated Jan. 23rd, 1934 and recorded in the Greenville
County S. C. Office in Vol. 177 at page 407.
