(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged). Have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Frank N. Quisen and Mary H. Quisen their heirs
and assigns forever:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of
land situate, lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid, near the corporate limits of the
City of Greenville, and being known and designated
as a portion of Lot no 6, of the Bust property
according to a plat of record in Plat Book E,
page 105, and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the south side
of Mountain View Avenue at the joint corner of
Lots 5 and 6, which point is 500 feet east of
Rutherford Street, and running thence with
said Mountain View Avenue, S. 65° 30' E. 75 feet
to a stake; thence S. 30° W. 189.5 feet to a stake
on line of Lot no 15; thence with line of Lot
no 15, N. 65° 30' W. 75 feet to a stake at joint
corner of Lots nos 5, 6, 14, and 15; thence with
the joint line of Lots 5 and 6, N. 30° E. 189.5 feet to the
beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me
by the Equitable Assurance Society of the United States,
March 27, 1934 by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office
for Greenville County in Vol 172 at page 62."
