Reatnie McKinney:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: to-wit:

Beginning on the north side of Lee Road, near Paris Station at Louis Hall's corner at edge of concrete road and running thence N. 74-10 W. 207.42 feet along edge of said concrete road; thence N. 15-50 E. 210 feet; thence S. 74-10 E. 207.42 feet to Hall's back corner; thence with his line S. 15-50 W. 210 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one acre, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Eugenia Hall by Louis Hall by deed dated January 2, 1930, recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Deed Book 107, page 145.
