Decree

This is an action brought for the purpose of substituting Trustees for the Estate of Lillie Hawthorne, and upon reading the Complaint herein and the Master's Report, and after giving careful consideration to all issues raised, the Court is of the opinion that the relief prayed for in the complaint should be granted, and therefore, upon the motion of Daniel L. Cain, attorney for the plaintiffs;

It is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed, that the Master's Report be, and the same is hereby confirmed and made a part of the Decree of this Court, and

It Is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed Further, that the Greenville Woman's College be, and it is hereby substituted as Trustee for the Lillie Hawthorne Estate, in stead of the Pastor, Clerk, and Deacons of the First Baptist Church, and that the original Executors be permitted to make a final accounting and obtain their discharge from the Probate Court, and that the real estate belonging to said estate be transferred to said Greenville Woman's College, as Trustees, subject to the terms, conditions and trust as set out in the will of said Lillie Hawthorne; that the real estate now in the name of W. E. Mason, Chairman of the Lillie Hawthorne Estate, and in the name of Wm. Goldsmith, C. O. Milford, and W. E. Mason, as Trustees for the Estate of Lillie Hawthorne be transferred to said Greenville Woman's College by deed signed by said Trustees, and that the real estate now in the name of the Pastor, Clerk, and Board of Deacons of the First Baptist Church as Executors of the Estate of Lillie Hawthorne be transferred to said new Trustee by an endorsement upon the Record of said deed, and that a copy of this order be filed in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County for recording, and a copy be filed in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County with the other papers of the Lillie Hawthorne Estate.

It Is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed Further, that the defendants, or any one claiming under or through them, except Greenville Woman's College, as the new Trustee, be barred from any further interest or claim in or to the property herein transferred, and that all costs, fees and expenses of this action be paid by the present Trustees before the transfer of any assets to the new Trustee.
