All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in ward Two City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following mates and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of a brick building of J. W. Goddard on Brown Street, and running thence with his line S. 88-34 E. 142.5 feet, to an iron pipe on line of J. R. Hooper; thence with his line S. 19-45 E. 43.3 feet to iron pin; thence N. 70-0 E. 142.4 feet to corner of building of T. V. L. Fahnstock on Brown Street; thence with line of Brown Street N. 19-37 E. 46.8 feet to the beginning corner, according to survey and plat made by R. E. Dalton, Eng. Feb. 1919.
