(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M.D. Littlefield, his heirs and assigns:

All that parcel or tract of land about one miles west of the Town of  
Greer, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Chick Springs Township, and  
having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point in the center of the Smith  
Road 20 feet west of an iron pin, and runs thence with the center of the road to the  
center of the National Highway; thence nearly west following the National Highway to its  
intersection with the public road leading to Gilreath's Mill on the C. L. King line;  
thence N. 31.28 W. to an iron pin on the W. W. Burgess line; thence S. 74.11 E. 897 feet  
to a point at the beginning, and designated as lots Nos. 52 to 55 inclusive on a plat  
of the W. H. Brockman lands, made by Dalton and Neves, Surveyors, on file in the R. M. C.  
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, page 132, being the same tract of land  
conveyed by E. Inman, Master to the Receivers of the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina  
by deed dated March 9, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
in Book 169, at page 83.

This deed intends to and does hereby convey all of the undivided one-half  
interest in the above described land owned by the late R. D. Dobson at the time of his  
decease.
