I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *A. D. Hightower*

on or about the *21st* day of *December* in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and *twenty-five* exhibited *his* complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against *J. F. Hightower, et al.*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *19th*  
day of *March*, 19*26*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the  
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after  
having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the *7th* day of *January* in the year of our Lord  
nineteen hundred and *twenty-nine*, and then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions,  
sell and dispose of the same unto *M. K. Hodges*

for the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars,  
being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the  
sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars  
to me paid by the said *M. K. Hodges*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto  
the said *M. K. Hodges*

"All the right, title and interest of Hodges  
Hightower, the same being an undivided one-  
sixth interest in and to the following described  
real estate.

All those three certain tracts of land, sites, etc.,  
lying and being in Saluda Township, County of  
Greenville, and State of South Carolina, on both  
sides of Saluda River and on Big Fall Creek and  
Little Fall Creek, waters of said Saluda River, said  
tracts of land being known as all of tract No. 3  
and one-half of tracts Nos. 1 and 2 in the survey of  
the land of Isyphenia Hightower made by W. A. &  
Hudson and J. M. Southern in 1892; Tract No. 3 contain-  
ing, according to said survey, 114 <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> Acres, one-half  
of Tract No. 1 containing 65 Acres, and one-half of  
Tract No. 2 containing 41 Acres; the whole of said  
tract, <sup>land</sup> was conveyed to John F. Hightower by D. P.  
Verner, Master, by deed dated November 7, 1892, and  
recorded in Deed Book A.A., Page 770, R. M. C. Office  
for Greenville County, and thereafter all of said Tract  
No. 3 and a part interest in Tracts Nos. 1 and 2 were  
conveyed by said John F. Hightower to Mary C.
