I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Nora C. Whitmire, in her own right and as Administratrix of the Estate of  
W. A. Whitmire,

on or about the 21st day of February in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty six exhibited her complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Jerry Coleman, et al

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th  
day of May, 1936, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the  
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after

nineteen hundred and thirty six, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions,  
sell and dispose of the same unto Nora C. Whitmire.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the  
sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) Dollars  
to me paid by the said Nora C. Whitmire,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto  
the said Nora C. Whitmire,

"All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, conveyed to John  
T. Hill by R. P. Devernette by deed dated May 24, 1920, recorded in R. M. C. Office for said  
County and State in Book 48, page 418, and therein described as follows: Beginning at an  
iron pin at the junction of the White Horse and Pickens Roads and runs thence with the center  
of White Horse Road, S. 65 1/2 W. 147 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36 E. 116 feet to an iron  
pin; thence N. 56 3/4 E. 177 1/2 feet to an iron pin in Pickens Road; thence with the center of  
said road, N. 55 1/2 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing 38/100 of an acre, more or  
less. Being the same land conveyed to W. A. Whitmire by Fred N. Hill by deed dated April  
13, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 115, page 434.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, about one and one half Miles west of the City of Greenville. Having  
the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the edge of Street, joint corner of  
A. B. Hodgans; thence S. 25-45 E. 188 feet to a stake; thence S. 72-50 W. 70 feet to a stake;  
thence N. 25-50 W. 183 feet to a stake; thence N. 68-21 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.  
Being lot No. 2 of subdivision of G. M. Cox property. Being the same lot of land conveyed  
to W. A. Whitmire and Nora Whitmire by G. M. Cox by deed dated December 15, 1922, and
