All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Cleveland town-  
ship in the State and County aforesaid on Waters of Middle Saluda River, containing twenty  
acres (20) more or less. Being plat No. 4 made by E. C. Edens, Surveyor, November 14, 1935,  
Plat attached. The piece of land situated near the Jones Gap road adjoining lands of Mrs.  
Rachel Robinson Lockaby; Carrie Robinson, William Henry Robinson, and the new place. Being  
my one fourth interest in the estate of my late father Harvey Robinson being part of the
