KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Lois Boddy

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand, Six Hundred and Seventy (\$7,670.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Bertha E. Simister
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Relapsed, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Bertha E. Simister, her heirs and assigns:-
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in
the City and County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, on the northern side of West Earle Street,
and designated as Lot #A, and a portion of lot #B
of Map 6 according to a plat of the property of
Mountain City Land & Improvement Company,
recorded in Deed Book 2121, at page 604, and having,
according to a recent survey thereof, made by Dalton
& Nease Engineers, October, 1931, the following courses
and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin 226 feet west of the
northwestern intersection of West Earle and Wilson
Streets, and running thence N. 6-47 E. 200 feet to an
iron pin in the line of a 16 foot alley; thence
along the southern line of said alley, N. 83-13 W.
100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6-47 W. 200 feet to
an iron pin in the line of West Earle Street, thence
along the northern line of said street S. 83-13 E. 100
feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same tract of land conveyed to Dr.
J. T. Boddy under two deeds, one by M. C. Brockman,
dated June 30, 1925 and recorded in the R. M. L.
Office in Deeds Vol. 103, page 154, and the other by
E. Turner, Master, dated June 30th, 1926, and re-
corded in said office in Deeds Vol. 67, page 164,
and willed to me by Dr. J. T. Boddy, which will
is on file in the office of the Probate Court for
Greenville County in Apartment 329, File 30.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance
the Grantee assumes payment of that certain mortgage
given by Dr. J. T. Boddy to the South Carolina Security
Company in the amount of \$8,000.00 dated October
6th, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. L. Office for
Greenville County in mortgages Volume 330, page 60,
and subsequently assigned to the Metropolitan Life
Insurance Company, on which there is a balance
now due and outstanding of \$6,080.00, with interest
from May 12th, 1936.
