a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at
Slater in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of
the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Roy R. Gowan, Pastor, and W. G. Hill, Smith Styles, Harvey McPherson, T. H. Laddox, W. P. Terrell, J. P. Futch, M. C. Remore, W. G. Carter, R. E. Shirley, J. N. McFadden and J. R. Wood as deacons of Slater Baptist Church, and their successors in office.

All that lot of land in the village of Slater, Greenville County, S. C., beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Edison Street, 12.33 feet from the curb line and running East with that street 100 feet to the corner of Edison and Whitney Streets thence running South with Whitney Street, and 12.33 feet from its curb line 70.20 feet to an iron pin; thence running West parallel to Edison Street 104.25 feet to an iron pin; thence running North 70 feet to the beginning corner, containing one-sixth of an acre more or less, subject however to the conditions referred to above which are as follows:

The above described lot to be used exclusively for religious purposes by Slater Baptist Church so long as it is associated with the State (South Carolina) Baptist Convention, it being the purpose of this grant that the lot shall not be used for any purposes other than those of a regular Baptist Church. Should it cease to be so used for a period of three months then the lot and the buildings thereon shall revert to the grantor, its successors and assigns.
