All that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Saluda

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being a portion of the property of R. G. Ballenger as shown on plat made by Justice & Miller, Engineers, of Hendersonville, N. C., being located on the east side of U. S. Highway No. 25 leading from Greenville, S. C. to Hendersonville, N. C. and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the center of the Callahan Mountain Road, which is the same road leading to the Greenville Boy Scout Camp, and running thence in a northerly direction with the east side of said U. S. Highway No. 25, 1100 feet to a stake; thence in a straight line at right angles with said Highway and in an easterly direction 225 feet, more or less, to a stake in the center of the north fork of the Saluda River; thence down the meanders of said river to a stake in the center of said Callahan Mountain Road, which stake is under the bridge of said Road; thence in a straight line in a westerly direction 157 feet more or less to the beginning.
