all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville ~~xxxxxx~~ Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in Ward Five on the South side of Douthit Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the South side of Douthit Street 200 feet from the corner of Leach and Douthit Streets and running thence along the South side of Douthit Street N. 71½ W. 183 feet to Lawton Avenue; thence along the East side of Lawton Avenue S. 18½ W. 61 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 2; thence S. 71½ E. 183 feet along line of Lot No. 2; thence N. 18½ W. 61 feet to the beginning corner.

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, known as Lot No. 2 on a plat made by W. A. Hudson and recorded in Plat Book A, page 135, (the first lot above described being known as Lot No. 1) and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the East side of Lawton Avenue 61 feet Southward from Douthit Street and running thence S. 18½ W. 50 feet along Lawton Avenue to a stake; thence S. 72½ E. 183 feet along line of Lot No. 3, belonging to I. W. Wingo, to a stake; thence N. 18½ E. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 72½ W. 183 feet along line of Lot No. 1 to the beginning corner.
