It is further expressly understood and agreed that in the event the said Duke Power Company, its successors, or assigns shall abandon the use of said lot, piece or parcel of land for the purpose hereinabove set forth, and shall remove, take and carry away from same, all its apparatus, appliances and other property, then, and in that event, this lease shall terminate and the said Duke Power Company, its successors or assigns, shall surrender said premises to the said party of the first part.
