F. Baule of Greenville County, South Carolina the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby release and forever discharge, for myself my heirs, executors and administrators, the said B. F. Baule his heirs, executors and administrators of and from all debts, claims, demands actions, causes of action and liabilities whatsoever both in law and equity, which I now have or may hereafter have against the said B. F. Baule on account of personal injuries received by me when I accidentally received a gun shot wound from a pistol in the hands of B. F. Baule on or about the 15th day of April 1936 at Fountain Inn, South Carolina.

I do hereby further release and discharge the said B. F. Baule from any and all debts, claims, demands or liabilities whatsoever which I may now have or may hereafter have against him or his estate on account of services rendered or on account of any relationship which may have existed between me and the said B. F. Baule at any time in the past or which may arise at any time ~~in the past or which may exist at any time~~ in the future on account of said relationship.

It is the purpose of this Release and Discharge to forever fully and completely settle all claims, demands and liabilities whatsoever between the parties to this Release.

I further agree never to interfere with molest or bother the said B. F. Baule or have any personal relationship with him at any time in the future.
