

The undersigned P. S. Parker being the owner of a piece of land in the Butler township in the county of Greenville State of S.C., fronting on the street or highway known as Datanilla Road and bounded on the north by the land of D. F. Smith on the south by the land of L. W. Ford.

In consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) received from the State Rural Electrification Authority, a corporation, here by given and grants unto said authority, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, erect, operate and perpetually maintain a pole line with the necessary wires, cross arms, guy wires and other usual fixtures and appurtenances used or adapted for the transmission of electric current for light, heat, power or any other purpose, on the said street or highway known as Datanilla Road on the land described as follows: bounded on the East by S. W. Smith, bounded on the west by Mrs. Baker.

Also the right, privilege and authority to cut or trim trees along said line necessary to keep the wires thereof clear at least twenty (20) feet.

Provided, however, any damage (other than tree damage) to the property of the undersigned, caused by the said authority in maintaining or repairing said electric transmission line, shall be borne by said authority, its successors and assigns.
