KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENVILLE, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five and 00/100 Dollars to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by

Mrs. J. P. Halliday  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. J. P. Halliday South half of Lot No. 57-1 of SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY having the following dimensions, to-wit: North 8 1/4 feet, East 11 feet, South 8 1/4 feet,

West 11 feet

for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the rights and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City, and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. J. P. Halliday her heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Mrs. J. P. Halliday, her

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors in office and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
