in SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY having the following dimensions to-wit:

North eleven feet, East sixteen and one-half feet, South eleven feet and West sixteen and one-half feet.

to be held of, and to be used exclusively for the rights and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said City and all ordinances, resolutions and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City, and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to and singular the said O. K. Schivers and B. D. Pinckney, their heirs and assigns forever, subject however to the limitations and conditions aforesaid.

And I, O. K. Schivers and B. D. Pinckney, their heirs and assigns, together with and its successors in office and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said O. K. Schivers and B. D. Pinckney, their

heirs and assigns, together with and its successors in office and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
