Whereas, by an order of Hon. J. Lyles Glenn, U.S. District Judge dated February 12, 1932, in a Proceeding entitled Ira Krupnick, Complainant against Peoples State Bank of South Carolina et al, Defendants, William Elliott, Robert Gage and N. M. M. Dill as Receivers of Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, were authorized and empowered to appoint W. Royden Watkins and/or E. W. Mullins their attorneys with the powers as set forth in said order; and were further authorized and empowered to appoint such additional agents or attorneys with like powers as above enumerated, as in their judgment may be necessary or advisable; and

Whereas, N. M. M. Dill resigned as such Receiver, his resignation was accepted by the U. S. District Court, and the powers vested in William Elliott, Robert Gage and N. M. M. Dill as Receivers of said Bank were continued in William Elliott and Robert Gage as such Receivers; and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary and advisable to appoint an additional attorney under the powers vested in said order;

Now, therefore, Know All Men By These Presents that we, William Elliott and Robert Gage, as Receivers of Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, do hereby appoint Herbert M. Wayne of Columbia, S.C. our attorney, to collect and receive all sums of money now due or hereafter to become due to the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, or to us as Receivers of said Bank, whether from or on account of notes, bonds, mortgages, drafts, bills of exchange, rents, accounts or otherwise, and upon payment thereof to give good and sufficient receipts, or other discharges therefor, and to give and execute releases and satisfaction of mortgages, judgments and all other debts, and to execute such other instruments in writing of whatever kind or nature as the case may require, and also, for us and in our name, to assign, transfer and set over to the obligor or assignor, any and all collateral, such as notes, bonds, mortgages, or other evidence of indebtedness, shares of stock, policies of insurance, choses in action and any other property real or personal which has been assigned to the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, as collateral to a loan or loans made to such obligor or assignor, upon the payment to him of the indebtedness due the said Peoples State Bank of South Carolina and secured by said collateral. Giving and granting unto the said Herbert M. Wayne, our said attorney, full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully to all intents and purposes as we might or could do if personally present, we hereby ratifying and confirming all that Herbert M. Wayne shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
