WHEREAS, Kenyon B. Zahner and Leyer L. Zahner, both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 6th day of July, 1938, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Double Cola Bottling Co. of Greenville

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to manufacture, compound, bottle, handle, buy and sell at wholesale or retail soft bottle drinks, also, mineral waters and other non-intoxicating beverages and drinks, with the power to own and hold such franchises, real or personal properties as may be incident to the business, together with the right to exercise all of the general powers conferred upon business corporations under the terms of the general laws of South Carolina.

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FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Forty thousand (\$40,000.00)

payable in cash or property on the call of the Board of Directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is four hundred (400) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 5th day of July, 1938 at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: Kenyon B. Zahner and Leyer L. Zahner

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President Kenyon B. Zahner as Vice-President, Leyer L. Zahner; as Secretary, Leyer L. Zahner as Treasurer, Kenyon B. Zahner

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent, of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
