(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Hattie Burtz, her heirs and assigns forever;*  
All that certain lot or parcel of land situate near Golden Grove, in the State and County aforesaid, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, beginning at a stone 3x thence S. 45° W. 225 to stone 3x thence N. 50° W. 225 to stone 3x thence N. 45° E. 225 to stone 3x, thence S. 57° E. 225 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Golden Grove Church, Payne and others. This being the same land conveyed to Golden Grove Lodge #32 of the Good Samaritans by deed recorded in the Office of Register of Mesne Conveyance in Deed Book *PP* page *236* on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 1884.
