all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in Ward I of the City of Greenville, being on the Northwest corner of West Stone Avenue and Robinson Street, and being a portion of Lot No. 6, Section D of the Stone Land Company, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin, which pin is 12 inches from the inside edge of the sidewalk at the Northwest corner of West Stone Avenue and Robinson Street, and runs thence with Robinson Street N. 6-47 E. 120 feet to a point; thence N. 76-46 W. 88.75 feet to a point; thence S. 6-47 W. 120 feet to an iron pin, which iron pin is 12 inches from the inside edge of the sidewalk on West Stone Avenue; thence with West Stone Avenue S. 76-46 E. 88.75 feet to the beginning.
