and containing 17.50 acres, adjoining lands of S. S. Ashmore, L.S. Jenkins, Jr. and others and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, corner of land of L.S. Jenkins, Jr., and running thence with his line N. 33-45 E. 17.20 chains to iron pin, corner of J.S. S. Ashmore land; thence with line of his land S. 89-45 W. 18.07 chains to iron pin; thence S. 47-45 W. 5.63 chains to iron pin; thence S. 50-35 E. 16.41 chains to the beginning corner. Being a portion the 69 acre tract of land devised to S. S. Jenkins et al by Mary M. Ashmore and being the same land conveyed to S. S. Jenkins by B. S. Indian Master by deed dated May 13th 1924, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 64 page 133.
