

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *James W. Brockman and John Ralph Brockman*

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the East side of Wardlaw Street beginning at a point at *Boouris'* Northwest corner, which point is 245 feet North of the Southwest corner of a stone wall on *Phelt* and *Wardlaw* Streets; and running thence with *Boouris'* line in an Easterly direction and parallel to *Phelt* Street 150.5 feet to *A. N. Park's* line; thence in a Northerly direction with *A. N. Park's* line, 50 feet; thence in a Westerly direction parallel with *Phelt* Street 150 feet to *Wardlaw* Street; thence with *Wardlaw* Street 50 feet to the beginning corner.
