The following restrictions shall be imposed against said

2. No dwelling shall be erected on said lot nearer
 than 15 feet to McElroy Street.
3. No dwelling or residence shall be erected on said
 lot costing less than \$1,000.00.
4. The above property shall not be leased, rented, sold, or
 otherwise disposed of in any manner to persons of African
 descent.
