That tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C. known as part of the land conveyed to J. B. Thompson by deed from J. W. Gray, Master, and a part of lot No. 12 in the division of Gabe Thompson estate, adjoining lands of J. B. Thompson, William Thompson, and others, and Beginning on an iron pin on the White Horse Road, thence running N. 34 W. 1.10 to fork of Road; thence with the Finley Bridge Road N. 58 W. 8.25 to a stake; thence S. 51 1/2 W. 12.50 to a stake on branch; thence up said branch to stake on branch; thence N.
