paid me by the said *Mary Mack Joseph*, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mary Mack Joseph and her heirs and assigns forever, all *that certain piece of land lying and being in Ward One of the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the corner of John and Hudson Streets and running thence N. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 74 feet to an iron pipe at corner on Hudson Street; thence N. 52 W. 150 feet, more or less, to corner of Anderson and Heyward's lot; thence S. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 70 feet to a pin on John St. at corner of Heyward's lot; thence S. 50 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner. Bounded by lots of Anderson and Heyward, by Hudson St., and John Street. This is the same land which was conveyed to the said Helen Killingsworth by R. C. Watkins by deed dated June 15, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for said Greenville County in Deed Book 166, page 210.
