(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. Rosco Stephens, his heirs and assigns forever:

A portion of that piece, parcel or tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, on the Anderson Road, two and three-fourths (23/4) miles from Greenville, S. C., containing seven and one-half (7 1/2) acres, more or less. Having such marks and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a stake at the ford of the Branch of Brussey Creek; thence along the meanders of the run to a stone formerly a Black Gum; thence N. 71 1/2 E. 7.00 to a stake; thence N.25 W. --- to the center of the New Anderson Road; thence with the center of said road to a point on or near the Piedmont and Northern Rail Road, thence running along or near the said rail-road to the beginning corner S. side branch.
