Beginning at a point in the center of Mostella Road at intersection of New Road and running thence; with the New Road, S. 40.20 W. 235 feet to bend; thence S. 30.20 W. 100 feet to bend; thence S. 20.20 W. 100 feet to bend; thence S. 10.20 W. 100 feet to bend; thence S. 0.20 W. 163 feet to a stake in center of the New Road; thence S. 87.55 E. 271 feet to Mrs. Nannie Findlay's line; thence with her line, N. 1.10 W. 566 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 6.15 E. 62 feet to the center of the Mostella Road the beginning corner and being known and designated as Tract No. 8, of the J.
